Over three years, supervisors from 231 municipalities have been trained. The training has reached approximately 60% of the municipalities that have crossing guards.

Over the years, municipalities have sent multiple officers to the training, as well as new supervisors as they take on the supervisory role.






Are there any school crossings you consider challenging for pedestrians in the municipality(s) you serve?





How many school crossings in the municipality(s) you serve do you consider challenging for pedestrians?




Is the crossing located on a State, County or Municipal Road?
