What is PSEE?

Pedestrian Safety Education and Enforcement, also known as "Cops in the Crosswalk," is a comprehensive half-day training program that was developed in collaboration with NJDOT, NJDHTS, Rutgers University, and NJPTOA in 2008 and which has been offered as the foremost pedestrian safety training for law enforcement since then. This training equips law enforcement personnel with essential knowledge and skills to address pedestrian safety concerns. Officers will gain insights into New Jersey's pedestrian laws (Title 39), learn about the synergistic impact of the 3Es (Education, Enforcement, and Engineering) on safety improvement, and understand operational protocols for road activities. These proven operations are not only effective but have been recognized as a primary initiative for pedestrian safety by law enforcement agencies. Additionally, these operations can serve as a vital foundation for NJ Street Smart Safety Campaigns and make departments eligible for NJDHTS pedestrian safety grants.

What is included?

The NJDHTS is generously funding this training initiative, with the training being offered through a partnership with VTC and CEC. In coordination with the Middletown Police Department, we're extending this opportunity to police departments that share a strong commitment to pedestrian safety in your region.
